### Virtual Primer on Peritoneal Dialysis

1. Register collectively as an institution. Please accomplish the enrollment link on or before January 15, 2022.

2. The primary registrant is the Training Officer of the institution. He will act as the contact person for the entire course.
3. The slots are allotted for the current Nephrology Fellows in-training, three (3) members of the training core (including the training officer) and three (3) nurses that will be designated as the PD nurses.
4. A link will be provided to access the recorded training modules from January 24 31 to April 24, 2022.
5. As an institution, it is encouraged to set a timeline to complete watching all the modules.
6. Another registration link will be provided for the scheduled virtual skills demo and return demonstration. This will be conducted separately by the PD nurse trainers from Fresenius and Baxter. Each PD provider will send the training materials and other requirements for the virtual training to the institution. A pre-requisite to join this activity is that each participant must have completed Modules 1 to 4.
